Transport to/from Praha – Václav Havel airport

The Praha - Václav Havel airport is located northwest of the outskirts of Prague, approximately 20 kilometres from the city centre. Transportation to/from the airport to Prague is provided by (in ascending price order):

City public transport buses:

* Line No. 119 to/from the Nádraží Veleslavín Metro Station (green line – METRO A)

* Line No. 100 to/from the Zličín Metro Station (yellow line – METRO B)

* Special line AE - Airport Express from the Main Railway Station (operation 05.00 - 22.00, every 30 minutes)

Public shuttle bus from airport to the centre of Prague:

Standard shuttle bus transportation between the Václav Havel Airport Prague and the city centre, stopping at V Celnici street, in front of CSA terminal, 50 m from Republic Square - náměstí Republiky. This is close to the Hilton Prague Old Town and Marriott hotels). Runs daily every 30 minutes from 07:30 - 19:00.

Shuttle bus fare is CZK150 per person for a single ticket (transport from the airport to V Celnici street or vice versa). Please see www.prg.aero/en/parking-transport/transport/public-transit for full details.

By taxi:

Fare from the airport to Řež should be between CZK1200-1600. To Prague city centre, the fare is approximately CZK1100 -1300.

How to get to the meeting place at ÚJV Řež from Prague

By train

Train departures from Prague's Masarykovo nádraží station (see map below) towards Kralupy nad Vltavou every 30 minutes (line S4). Please disembark at Řež station. The bridge immediately behind the platform crosses the river and will lead you directly to the front entrance of ÚJV Řež.

The Masarykovo nádraží train station is located in the city centre at the Metro station Naměstí Republiky (yellow line - METRO B). Fare Prague-Řež-Prague is CZK67 (return ticket) and the tickets can be bought at the desk (see above) or on the train (at an extra cost of CZK50). But please note that, on the train, it is not possible to pay either by credit card or with Euros.

On the first day, we would suggest catching the train at 07:55 (arrives Řež at 08:13) for registration at the ÚJV entrance. For departure times and general information about public transport, we recommend the IDOS website (www.idos.cz) and mobile App (download via Google Play, AppStore, etc.)

Accommodation in Prague
